### Sainsbury's Vouchers

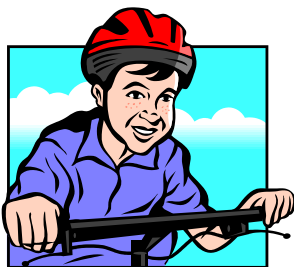
Although Sainsbury's have now stopped issuing vouchers it seems that people are still finding them at home. Please have a final look down the back of the sofa as we need to place our order soon!

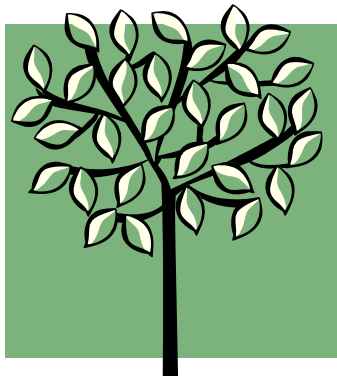
